

## 2011-2012 MT. LA CROSSE SEASON PASS \* Policy Agreement

\*For the purpose of this agreement, "Season Pass" refers to the unlimited pass as well as the *Daytime Deal Pass*, the *Twilight Ten Pass*, the *Child Pass*, and the *Sr. Citizen Pass*.

- Family refers only to people on the same tax form.
- Passes are not valid until a signed Season Pass Release of Liability Form or a Season Pass Agreement (No Release) has been submitted to Mt. La Crosse.
- The Season Pass Card must be presented at the ticket window to receive a daily lift ticket on EACH VISIT.
- Lost lift tickets must be immediately reported and replacement is subject to manager approval. Passes are non-transferable and non-refundable. In the event that a partial transfer is granted, Mt. La Crosse reserves the right to charge a processing fee.
- Lost season pass cards should be immediately reported to the ticket desk and can be replaced for a \$10.00 handling fee.

### In support of this application, I agree that:

1. All information contained in this application and submitted regarding my season pass is true and correct.
2. My skiing/snowboarding privileges are not transferable and **any use of my skiing/snowboarding privileges by any person other than me will result in immediate revocation, without refund, of all pass privileges for the remainder of the season and theft charges may be pressed.**
3. Mt. La Crosse reserves the right to make reasonable rules for the safety and convenience of its patrons and for the proper utilization of its facilities. I agree to learn and obey these rules. A listing of rules is posted inside the lodge, in the trail guide and at the ticket desk.
4. My season pass fee entitles me to lift privileges as stated when the ski area is open to the general public during the season for which the pass is issued.
5. Mt. La Crosse may use photos of me for various media and advertising promotions now or in the future.
6. Mt. La Crosse is not responsible for the loss of any personal effects or equipment that occurs while I am on their premises.
7. I understand that Mt. La Crosse may close entirely or close parts of the area at unexpected times for reasons including but not limited to the safety of its patrons, due to weather, lightning, high wind, etc., and I, furthermore do not expect any sort of reimbursement if this is to happen.
8. I understand that my skiing/snowboarding privileges may be revoked by engaging in illegal and/or disruptive behavior including but not limited to the use of foul language, violence, vandalism, and/or theft.
9. I understand and will follow the guidelines outlined in "**Your Responsibility Code**" (*listed as follows*)
  - Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
  - People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
  - You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
  - Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
  - Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
  - Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
  - Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.
